WELCOME

It is a huge pleasure to invite you to this year's Southern Cathedrals Festival in Winchester. Owing to the pandemic, seven years have passed since a full Festival was 'live' here.

We are introducing a few changes to this year's Festival which we hope you will enjoy. In order to ensure the future of this unique and much-loved celebration of sacred music, it is important we attract new followers. To this end, we're having what will, I think, be the first SCF 'Come and Sing' concert. In the centenary year of his death, it is most appropriate that the piece to be sung is Fauré's Requiem, led by one of the current most influential choral directors and composers, Bob Chilcott. Those who sign up to sing will be accompanied by members of all the Cathedral Choirs and it should be a stunning performance.

We are welcoming back to Winchester Jonathan Hope,
Assistant Director of Music at Gloucester Cathedral, who will
be improvising the music for the classic black and white film
The Phantom of the Operawell as showing the film
on a big screen, we will also be using cameras to show
Jonathan at the console.

We welcome some younger performers to the programme. Our Outreach will continue with local schools and there will also be a recital by two local Winchester residents, Verity and Laurie Sawbridge. Verity, a former Winchester girl chorister, is a choral scholar at Merton College, Oxford and Laurie is a music scholar at Winchester College.

We are replacing the more formal Festival Lunch with a more relaxed hog-roast at the Cathedral Café. We hope that this will enable us to meet and socialise, and build up the bond of the large SCF family.

Saturday evening's concert will include a work commissioned for the 2011 Southern Cathedrals Festival. All too often, wonderful pieces are given their first performance and then consigned to the back of the music library, Leonard Bernstein's Chichester Psalms (commissioned for the 1965 Southern Cathedrals Festival) being the most famous exception. This year, Philip Moore's marvellous piece for brass and choir 'At the round earth's imagined corners', a setting of a poem by John Donne, will be performed again.

.... and the Winchester Fringe returns – one definitely not to be missed.

It will be a great joy for the three choral foundations of Chichester, Salisbury and Winchester, to be together again and we very much hope that you will be able to join us too.
